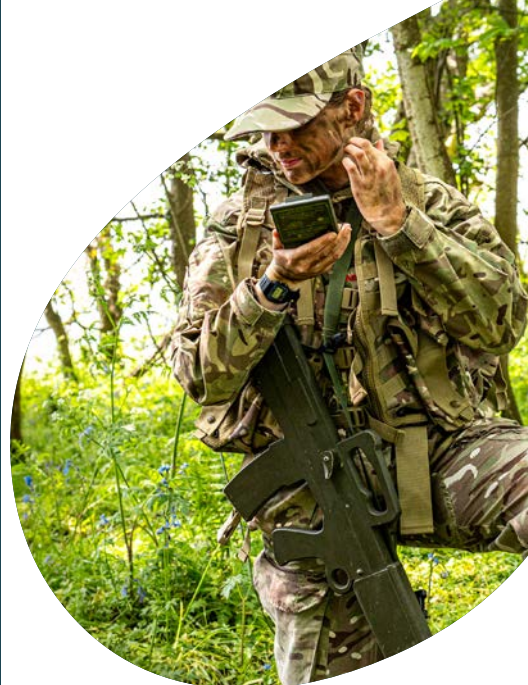




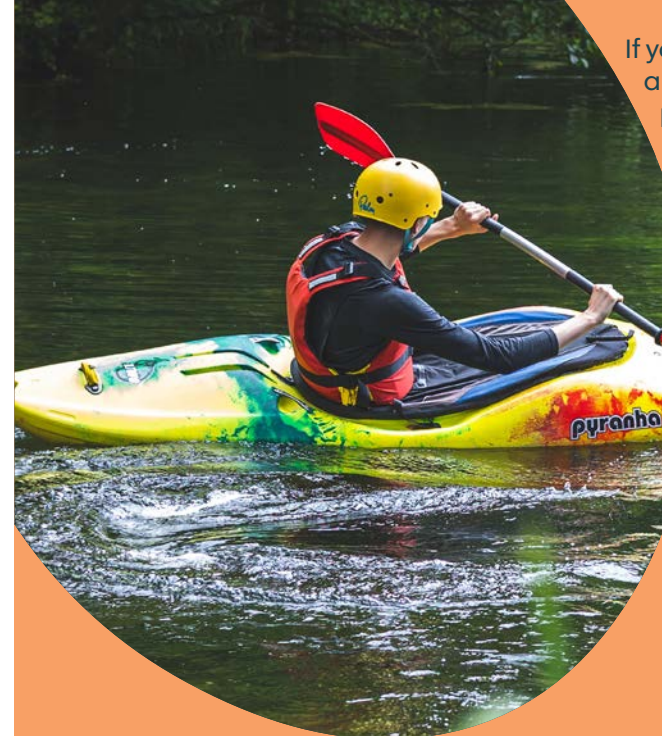

At Coastland College, you can continue your educational journey with degree level courses in land-based subjects, including foundation degrees and HNDs, with opportunities to progress to full BSc (Hons) qualifications.

We also offer part-time short courses for those starting out in teaching or developing training skills. Options include Level 3 Award in Education and Training evening course and the Level 5 Diploma in Teaching (FE and Skills), taught as a day release programme for those teaching in the Further Education or post-16 sector.
